CTC/NCKCN Offer Broadband Discount Program

Who Is Eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines
- Participates in one of these assistance programs: Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision; SNAP; Medicaid; Federal Public Housing Assistance; SSI; WIC; Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits; or Lifeline
- Participates in Tribal specific programs: Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations, or Tribal Head Start (Income based)
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income program

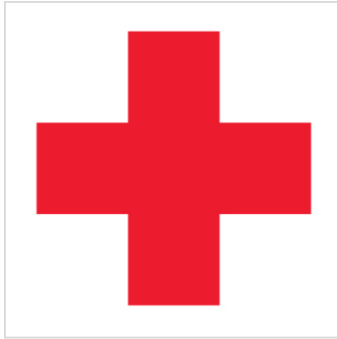

The Affordable Connectivity Program is a [Federal Communications Commission](https://www.fcc.gov) program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward

broadband service for eligible households.

Eligible households can enroll through a [participating broadband provider](#) or directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) using an [online](#) or mail in application.
